Toyota-Prius Trademark case: Del HC holds no infringement by *Prius Auto* [Read judgment]

A division Bench of the Delhi High Court today held that use of the trademark "Prius" by a Delhi based automobile accessories company, Prius Auto Industries, does not violate the trademark owned by Toyota Motors in the same.

The decision was rendered by a bench of **Pradeep Nandrajog** and **Yogesh Khanna, JJ.** which set aside the order passed by single-judge Bench of Justice Manmohan on July 8.

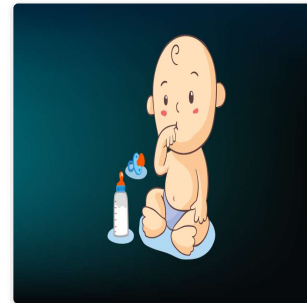
